<b>Cuairt</b> (b): walk, short excursion, ramble <b>Sgrìob</b> (b): A short walk or stroll <b>A' dol a' coiseachd</b> : Going walking <b>A' dol air cuairt</b> : Going for a walk/hike. <b>A' gabhail cuairt</b> : taking a hike, walk	<b>air an iteig</b> : flying <b>A' snàigeadh</b> : creeping/crawling <b>A' coiseachd</b> : walking <b>A' ruith</b> : running <b>A' ceilearadh</b> : warbling, singing (as in birds) <b>A' cladhach</b> : digging <b>A' ruamhradh</b> : digging, rooting around
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**Dè tha seo?** : What is this

**Dè tha sin?**: what is that

**Dè th' ann thall an siud?**: What's that over yonder?

**Nach tog thu sin?**: Won't you pick that up, please?

**An e lus no beòthach/beathach a tha ann/innte?**: Is it a plant or animal?

**Chi mi le mo shuilean bheaga, ruideigin a tha \_\_\_\_\_**: I spy w/my little eyes, something \_\_\_\_\_.

**Thalla agus lorg \_\_\_\_\_ dhomh**: Go and find me a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Cia mheud a tha agad?**: How many do you have?

**A' bheil a h-uile càil agad?**: Do you have everything?

**Dè tha dhìth ort?**: What are you missing?

**Càite an d' fhuair thu e/i?**: Where did you find it?

**Càite a' bheil e/i a' fuireach?**: Where does it live?

**A' bheil e/i mòr/beag/trom/fliuch/garbh/sleamhainn/tioram/?**: Is it big, heavy, wet, rough, slippery/smooth, dry?

**A' bheil e/i breagha no grànnda?**: Is it beautiful or ugly?

**A' bheil e/i beò no marbh?** : Is it alive or dead?

**Coisichibh!:** Walk y'all!

**Tiugainnibh!:** Come on y'all!

**Stadaibh:** Stop y'all!

**Seallaibh:** Look y'all!

**Gabhaidh sinn cuairt anns a' choille:** We'll take a walk in the forest.

**Gabhaidh sinn cuairt ri taobh na h-aibhne:** We'll take a walk by the river.

**Gabhaidh sinn cuairt thar na beinne:** We'll take a walk over the hills/mountains.

**Gabhaidh sinn sgrìob sìos an t-slighe seo:** We'll take a short walk down this trail.

**Can, Abair:** Say      **Dè chanas sibh ri seo?** What do you call this?

**Dè tha seo?** What is this?

**Anns a' choille:** In the forest

**An toil leat sin? Is toil/Cha toil:** Do you like that? Yes/No

**Ri taobh na h-aibhne:** By the river

**Bruach na h-aibhne:** the bank of the river, riverbank

**Tha dìle an-diugh 's an alltan dubh:** The black stream is flooded today.

**Anns a' choire:** In the hollow

**Cuirm-chnuic:** A picnic (also picnicing)

**Na h-Easan Móra:** Great Falls

**Na tuit anns na h-Easan Móra!:** Don't fall in the Great Falls!

**Gabhaidh sinn cuairt dha na h-Easan Móra:** We'll walk to Great Falls.

**Tha mo chasan/bhrògan fliuch!:** My feet/shoes are wet!

**Aon, dha, tri, ceithir, coig, sia, seach, ochd, naoidh, deich** (1-10)
